

Maintaining Student Disciplinary Actions & Proceedings as Educational Records Under FERPA - 1995

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Education has promulgated final regulations for implementation of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act; and

WHEREAS, these regulations identify student disciplinary actions and proceedings as educational records, and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Education has indicated that he has recommended to Congress that they reconsider the appropriateness of this inclusion; and

WHEREAS, it is the position of the Association to reaffirm the original intent of the legislation to maintain disciplinary actions and proceedings as educational records under FERPA; therefore be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the President of the Association write to each member of Congress and describe the position of the Association on this issue, in order to make Congress aware of that position; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Association take any action necessary in order to maintain student disciplinary actions and proceedings as educational records under FERPA.

This resolution was passed by the membership of the Association for Student Judicial Affairs at the 1995 Annual Business Meeting on Saturday, February 12, 1995.
